We have several weekly club rides available ranging from the leisurely rides to the more fast pace fitness rides. Some of our rides are fitness focused and others are more socially focused. We have something for everyone.

Ride Safe

- ANSI or Snell certified helmets required.
- Ride on the right.
- Ride in a straight line, don't weave.
- When passing another rider, look back to be sure it is clear and signal. When passing another cyclist, yell out "ON YOUR LEFT". When you hear someone calling out "On your left", do not turn around. Hold steady on course and ride straight.
- Glance back often, always before moving right or left.
- Point out hazards to your fellow cyclists following you by pointing.
- Watch out for sand and gravel.
- Talk to your fellow cyclists. Let them know "SLOWING", "RIDER UP", "PASSING ON YOUR LEFT", or "STOPPING".
- When stopping to rest, get off the pavement.
- Ride friendly and defensively.

Event Information

The BBC Spoke and Hub Century Ride will begin at the "Hub", Haworth Park in Bellevue on the Missouri River. Four "Spokes" are available to ride:

- Spoke 1 - 33 mi.**
Haworth Park to Glenwood and Pacific Junction, IA
- Spoke 2 - 25 mi.**
Haworth Park to Wabash Trail head via Meadowview Rd.
- Spoke 3 - 21 mi.**
Haworth Park to LaPlatte and Hanson Lakes
- Spoke 4 - 26 mi.**
Haworth Park to Culvers via the Bellevue Loop trail and back

All the spokes = 105 miles
 Spokes 1 and 2 may be combined and the lost miles made up by riding the Council Bluffs trail from the Wabash Trail head to the bridge at the west end of Lake Manawa and back.

Ride any distance you like, it's all about fun. Refreshments will be available at each spoke and the Hub. Entertainment will be available at the Hub. Sag support will be provided for minor repairs along the trails.
