Event Description: Smithville Lake will again be host to our annual cyclocross festival—9th year. The Smithville Cyclocross Festival is held at beautiful Sailboat Cove over the October 25th weekend.

<u>Course Description:</u> Course will be a 1.8 mile loop that includes pavement, grass, sand, steep run-ups, flowing turns and off camber turns all within Sailboat Cove Park on the shores of beautiful Smithville Lake

<u>Directions to course</u>: Smithville Lake is located in beautiful northwest Missouri, just north of Kansas City metropolitan area. To reach Sailboat Cove, take Highway W east from Highway 169 north of Smithville, Missouri, toward Paradise, MO, on the east side of Smithville Lake. On arriving in Paradise, turn west on Paradise road before the convenience store/gas station. Follow signs to race.

<u>Parking</u>: On event day, please remember that parking will be permitted in designated areas only. No exceptions will be made. Arrive early enough to park and register.

<u>Registration Instructions</u>: Online registration is with Sports Base Online. Save time and become eligible for raffle by registering at <u>www.sportsbaseonline.com</u>. Riders will be called to the line based on order of registration. Race day registration begins at 9:00am at the Sailboat Cove Park. Registration closes Twenty (20) minutes before posted start time. Enter a second race for an additional \$10.00.

- One day licenses available (fee \$10.00).
- ANSI approved helmets required for all events and must be worn at all times.
- Mountain bikes are allowed, but must have the bar ends removed.
- Events held regardless off inclement weather
- Entry fee includes \$3.00 for insurance and \$1.00 KCA Fee
